- 7.3 The Chief Officer is responsible for all general activities of the vessel as well as to cooperate with the instructors and experts in conducting the navigation and seamanship practice.
- 7.4 All staff should give full cooperation to activities in scope of the objective.

9. Financial Matters

SEAFDEC provide and advance in cash a total sum of the estimated expenses approved by Chief of the Training Department and all of the estimated travel and sea allowances at the established rates for all personnel who are authorized to go on board the vessel.
- 9.2 The Captain will be held accountable for the submission of expense accounts as aimed, along with the original copies of relevant vouchers and any unspent balance in cash, to the Administrative and Finance Division Head, through the normal lines of command, within a period of two weeks from the date of return of the vessel to the Department.

All officers concerned shall, within three weeks after return to the Department of the vessel, submit the reports of activities for which they are responsible during the cruise to the Training and Research Supporting Division Heads concerned for compiling the cruise report.

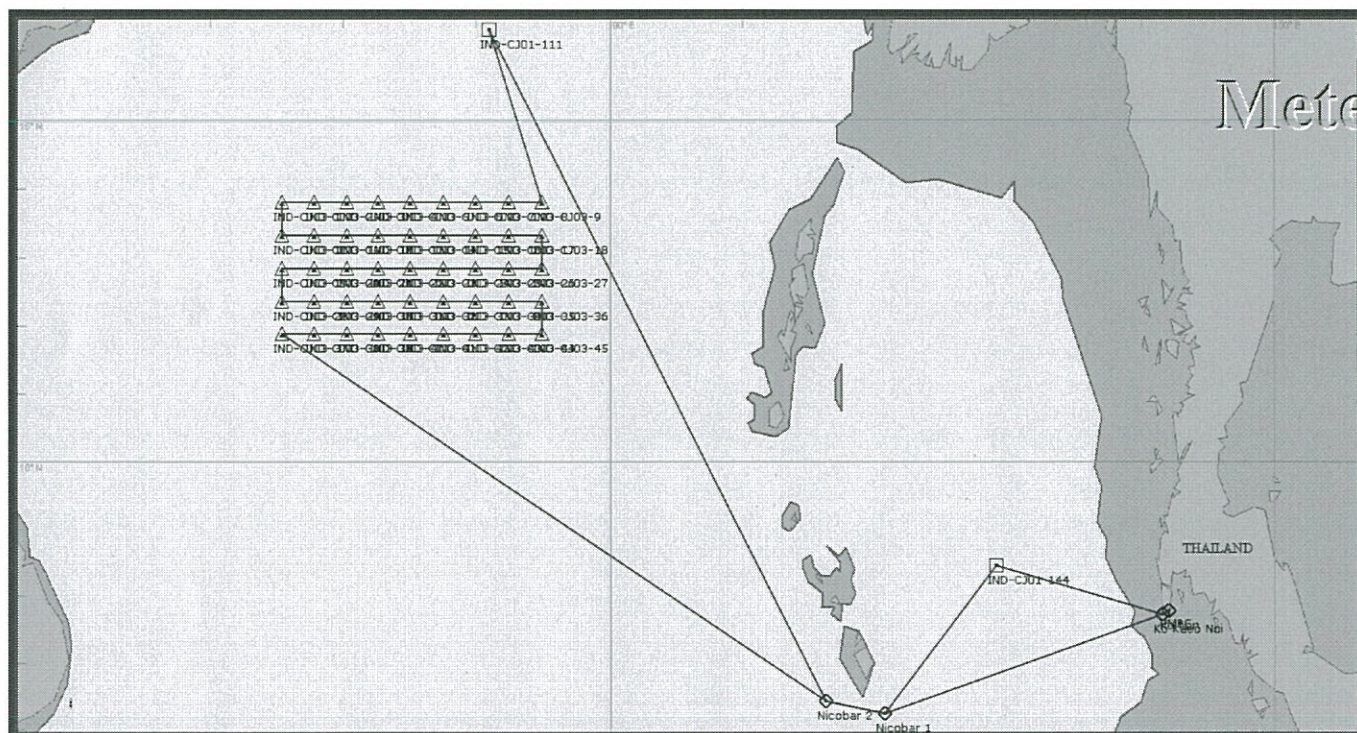
