



#### **BACKGOUND**

- MFMA is proclaimed by MAFF in April 2018
- MFMA's total area is 11.375 ha
- MFMA is divided into 4 zones
  - Conservation Area (112ha):
  - 2. Fisheries Refugia (420ha):
  - 3. Fisheries Protected Area (10040ha)
  - 4. Recreational and Research Area (405ha)

Manage by Kep authority and Dep. Fisheries Conservation and conduct research by MCC-Marine Conservation Cambodia

## ACHIEVMENT OF EACH ACTIVTY

- MFMA was approved by MAFF, April 2018
- Socio-demographic survey reports and marine survey reports
- Deployed 165 concrete block into conservation zone
- Crackdown illegal fishing, mainly trawling
- Release 2 sea turtles
- Study, monitor, evaluate seagrass and blue swimming crab stock in fisheries refugee zone;
- Java Rabbitfish, Black-spot Snapper and Monogram Monocle Bream are found associated with coral reef growth after deploying concrete block


