Background

- Year 2002- Reorganization of Ministry, Sub-Ministry, and Department Act, B.E. 2545
 - Establishment of Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment
- Department of Marine and Coastal Resources (DMCR) was founded in 2002.
 - Some government officers were transferred from Dept. of Fisheries, Dept. of Royal Forestry and Dept. Land Development , Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives to DMCR. (500 positions)

- Question was
“ How do the Dept. of Marine and Coastal Resources conserve and manage the marine and coastal resources along shoreline of 2,000 kilometers by 500 officers”.
- Answer was
“We need Partners”.



Marine and Coastal Resources

- Coral reefs, Mangrove, Sea grasses, Shores, Coastal lands, Marine lives, Fishes and so on.
 - Serve as important marine ecosystems
 - Food suppliers for Human
 - Natural coastal protection
 - Feeding and Nursery ground for young marine animals
 - Place for Living and Industrial development for Human
 - Create job employment

Coastal Conservation Networks

- Coastal Conservation Network Status
 - 464 Groups of 11,387 persons
 - Mangrove Resources 166 groups
 - Other Marine and Coastal Resources 270 groups
 - Others 27 groups
- Capacity Building
 - Technical Information Supporting
 - Marine Mammals and Sea Turtles
 - Artificial Reefs
 - Coastal Community's Products
 - Fishing technique
 - Marine and Coastal Resources: Corals, Mangrove, Sea grass, Shores, Coastal Erosion, Marine Litter, Marine Lives, etc.

Authorized government agency contributed modern knowledge and information and adding local knowledge to the local community for their capacity building.



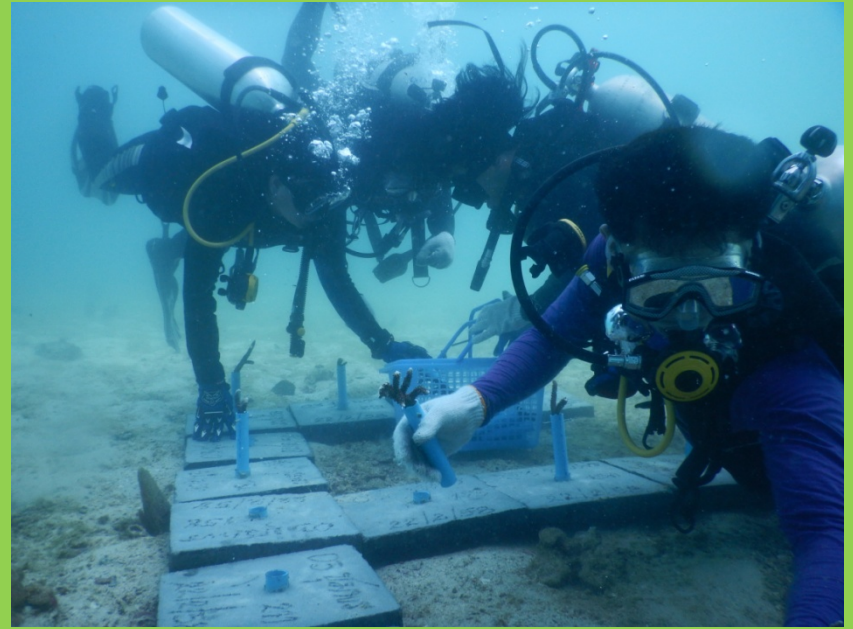
Budget

Authorized government agency supports officers and patrol boat for control and surveillance the illegal and destructive fishing.

Authorized government agency arranges and shares space on webpage as channel for local community for PR their activities, showcase and exchange information for public and among fishery communities.

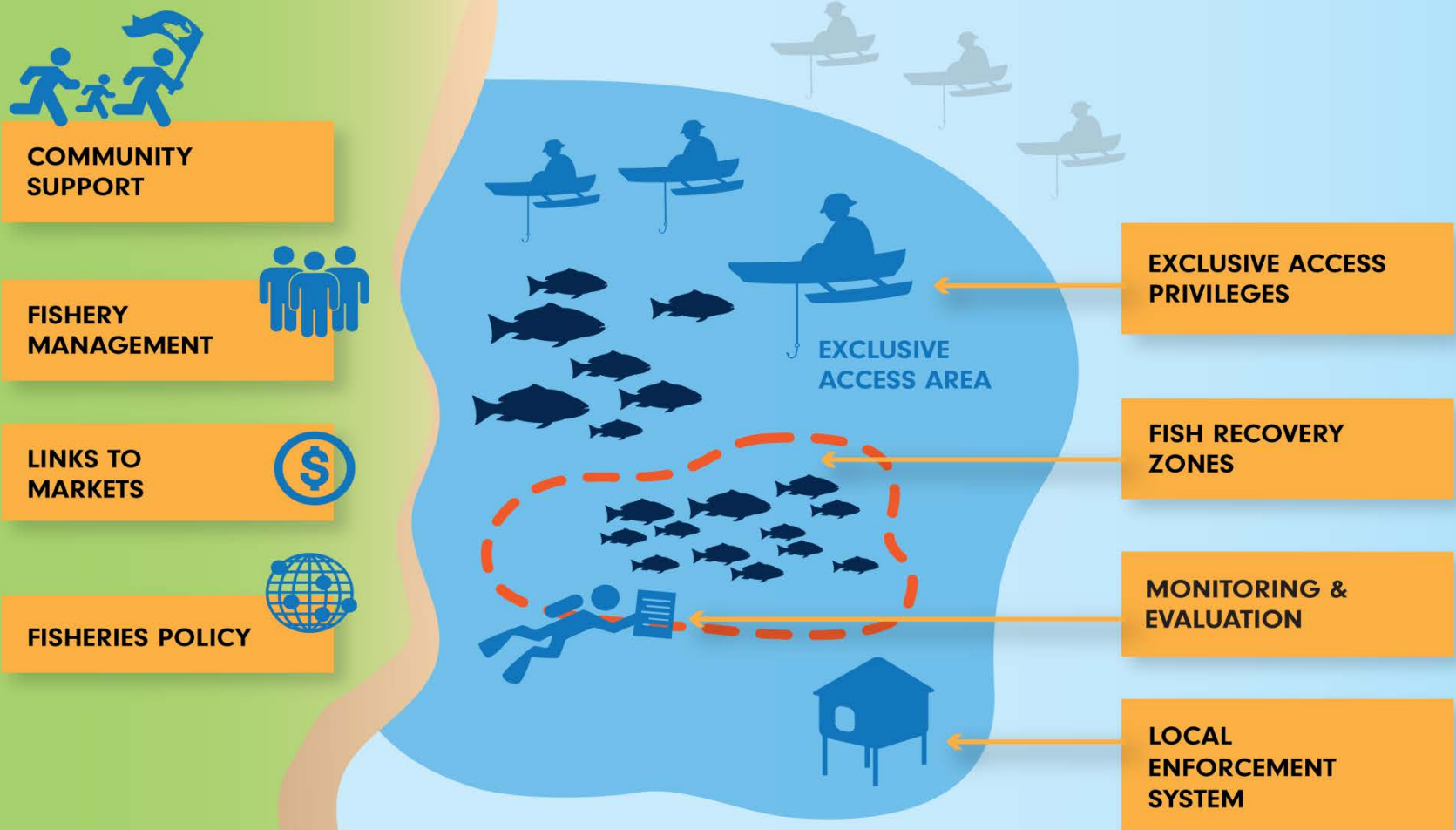
