
Gender Integration in Fisheries



Why Integrated Gender in Fisheries?

The Fisheries sector is often seen as male dominant



While women are mainly considered in post harvest and market



Therefore, Gender integration are needed in support of equal opportunities integration of gender aspects should be promoted to ensure better recognition and enhancement of the roles of women at regional, national, and local levels including governments, communities and private sector in the process.

Recommendation to Integrate Gender in Fisheries

- Gender Analysis to identify role, responsibilities, problems, needs, capacities, interest and level of participation of men and women in fisheries for planning process
- Implement
 - Practical needs (Immediate needs or the need in short term)
 Ex. Provide skill- building.
 - Strategic Interest (long term change) lead to changing roles, status and position. Ex. More women as leaders in fishery sector
- Gender sensitivity indicator for project monitor and evaluation Ex. No. or % of male or female participating in the project, Social status of women and men
