

**Prospectus of**  
**Training on the Use of eACDS Application in the Part of Catch Declaration (CD)**

*1. Introduction*

According to a request from Cambodia for technical assistance on the use of the application of the eACDS during the 44th Meeting of the SEAFDEC Program Committee in 2021. In response to this, the eACDS working team plans to organize training on the use of eACDS application in the part of Catch Declaration (CD) for Cambodia in 21-22 June 2023.

*2. Objectives*

- To impart knowledge on the use of eACDS application in the part of Catch Declaration (CD) for Cambodia officers.

*3. Date and Venue*

The training will be organized on 21-22 June 2023 (2 days) at Koh Kong Province, Cambodia as a pilot site,

*4. Participants*

The Fisheries Administrative (FiA) officers (8 persons: 4 from FiA Headquarters, 4 from FiA in Koh Kong Province) who engage in the eACDS activities and will be trainers for relevant stakeholders in the future.

*5. Expected outputs*

- FiA officers understood the use of eACDS application in the part of CD.
- Capacity building for FiA officers to be trainers for relevant stakeholders in the supply chain for the use of eACDS application in the part of CD in the future.
- Trail of eACDS application in the part of CD after completing this training.
