Current Container Inspection Practices



Information on current inspection practices

Before import

- Checking related document from country origin and destination country before a truck or container is imported;

At the border

- when the goods import arrive at the border, inspectors will physically check products and random sampling for screening analysis;

After import

- If a container is sealed, the container will be checked at a destination by inspector and provincial staff.

How to track containers:

- Inspector will follow a truck for our responsibilities areas;
- To contact with provincial staff.

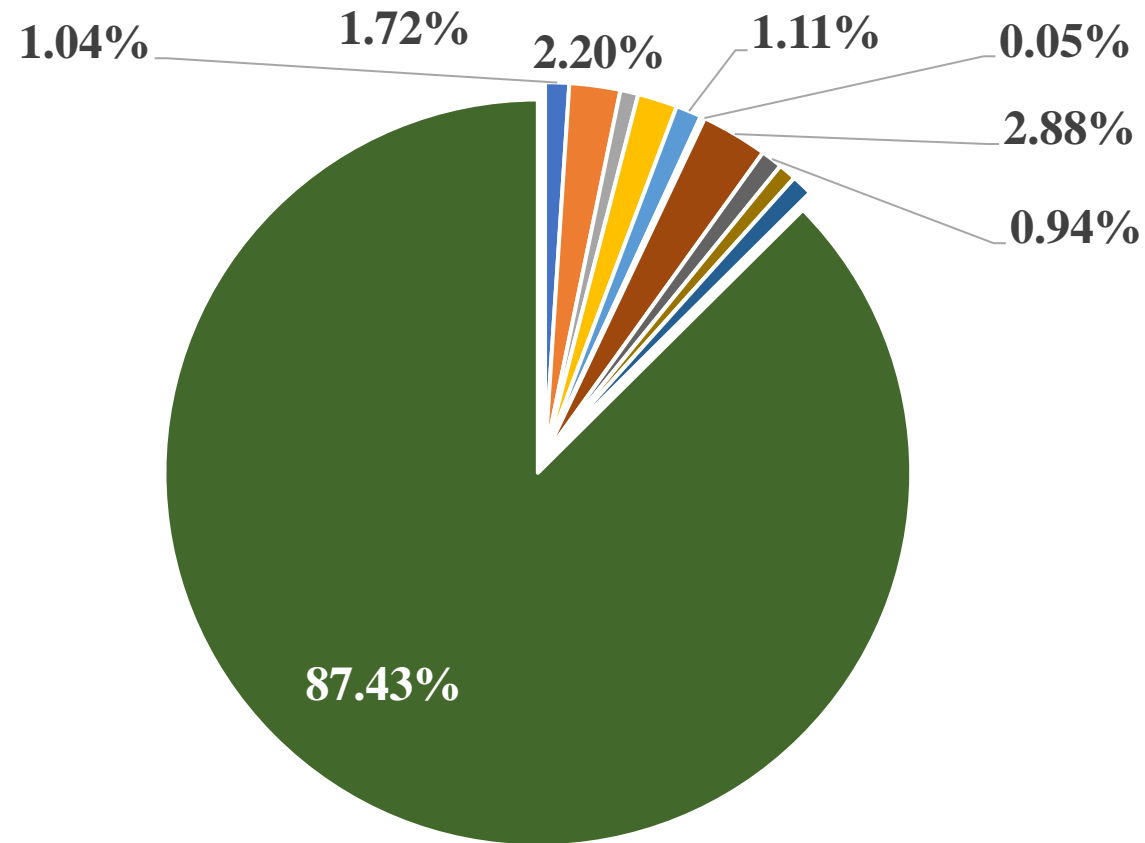
Challenges:

- Lao PDR does not have fishery container tracking system;
- Lack of equipment about fishery container import checking;
- Lack of fishery Inspector.

Which agencies are in charge of container imports:

- Government (Quarantine, custom, transport section);
- Private sector.
