During the training session, we will learn about the Vessel profiling tool in the Global Fishing Watch platform (globalfishingwatch.org/map/vessel-search) and its features for Port State Measures application and port control. 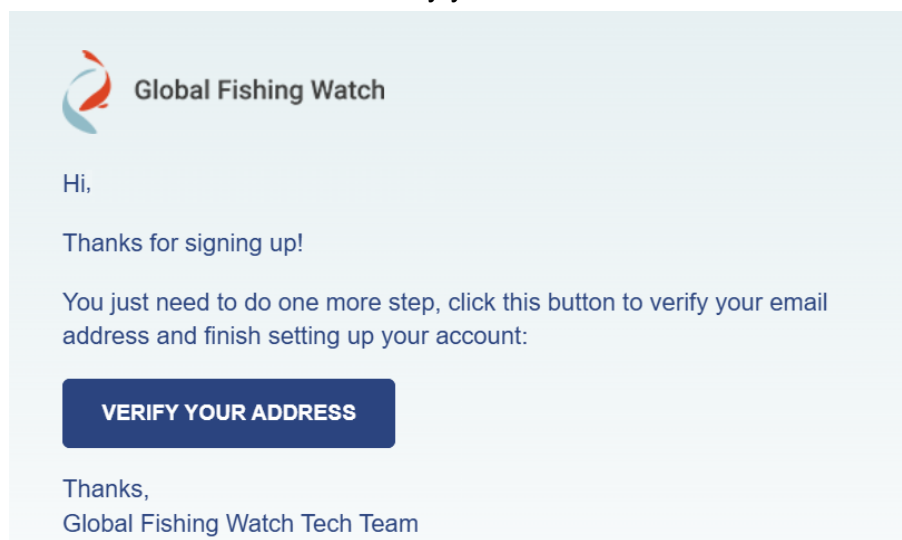

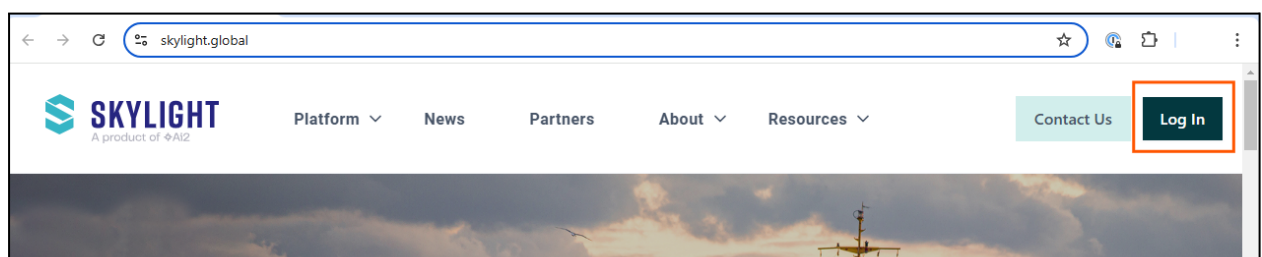

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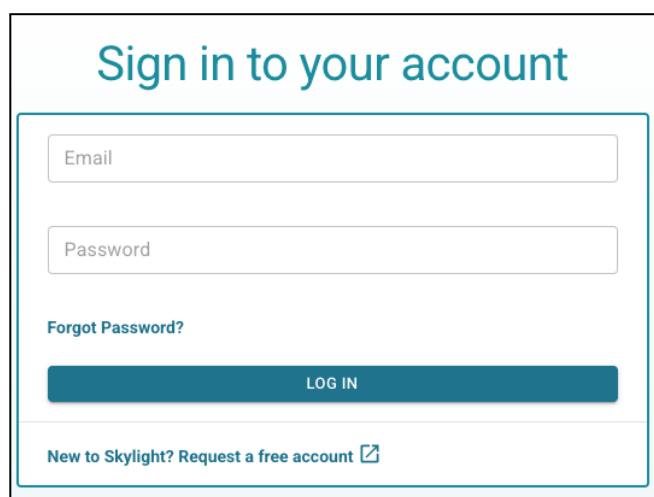
