Legislation on Import Control



• Royal Ordinance on Fisheries B.E.2558 (A.D. 2015) and its amendment (A.D. 2017)

Examples of relevant subordinate legislation:

- Notification of Department of Fisheries On Specified Criteria, Method and Condition to request for permission to import Aquatic Animal or Aquatic Animal Products B.E. 2560 (A.D. 2017)
- Animal Epidemic Act B.E. 2558 (2015)

The control of import, export and transit of fish and fishery production inputs to be complied with relevant laws and regulations is responsible by the Fish Quarantine and Fishing Vessels Inspection Division (FFID)










Locations of Fish Inspection Offices (FIO)










The importer must register to the Fisheries Single Window (FSW) system



The FIO officer issue an (one-time use only)

At importing day

The importer informs and presents the import permit and additional documents to FIO officers



FIO officer inspect species and quantity of fishery goods and verify data in all submitted documents

Risk assessment process

Accuse or fine the importer

- * Additional documents
- 1. Copy of Invoice
- 3. Copy of Packing list
- 5. Copy of Health Certificate
- 2. Copy of Bill of Lading or Airway Bill
- 4. Copy of catch certificate or a copy of custom clearance or a copy of custom declaration or export certification document of aquatic animal or aquatic animal products from respective government agency.

FIO = Fish Inspection office

^{*} In case of importing live non-native aquatic species, importer must submit documents to Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC) for consideration of imported risk.

Not sampling

Release goods

Sampling for monitoring



- If not detected, FIO release goods.
- If any <u>residue</u> is detected, FIO informs Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for further actions.


Seize or Quarantine & Sampling



- If not detected, FIO release goods.
- If any <u>disease</u> is detected, FIO destroy or disinfect by burning/landfill/boiling.
- If any <u>residue</u> is detected, FIO inform FDA for further actions.
