Legislation on Import Control



- Royal Ordinance on Fisheries B.E.2558 (A.D. 2015) and its amendment (A.D. 2017)

- Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979)

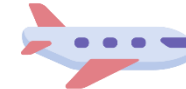

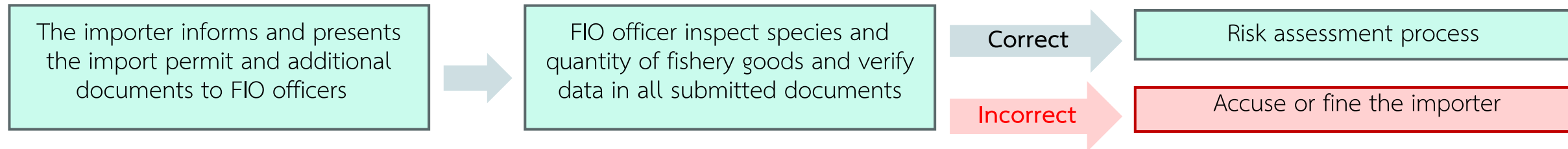
Procedure for Import Control

* Additional documents

1. Copy of Invoice
2. Copy of Bill of Lading or Airway Bill
3. Copy of Packing list
4. Copy of catch certificate or a copy of custom clearance or a copy of custom declaration or export certification document of aquatic animal or aquatic animal products from respective government agency.
5. Copy of Health Certificate

* In case of importing live non-native aquatic species, importer must submit documents to Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC) for consideration of imported risk.

Sampling for monitoring



- If not detected, FIO release goods.
- If any residue is detected, FIO informs Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for further actions.

Seize or Quarantine & Sampling



- If not detected, FIO release goods.
- If any disease is detected, FIO destroy or disinfect by burning/landfill/boiling.
- If any residue is detected, FIO inform FDA for further actions.
